


Achievement? Where?

 - Pressure on the labour market






Mozambique population pyramid:




Threat?

- Elderly people contribute less to the economy... Truth or myth? Are they really a burden to the society?










Elderly population in Mozambique (thousands) Urban and Rural – 2007-2020:

- Elderly people can be a valuable resource to the society, but this contribution is not guaranteed




Discussion 1/3:

Discussion 3/3:
